Profile:

Bernhard Schellberg is Professor of Business Administration, Corporate Restructuring. He joined the Faculty of Business Law in February 2000. Schellberg received a scholarship of the program for outstanding students (Konrad-Adenauer-Stiftung) and graduated in Business Administration (Diplom-Kaufmann) at Münster University. In 1993 he finished his dissertation "Insolvenzprognosemodelle" (Financial Ratios and the Prediction of Corporate Bankruptcy), and obtained his Dr. (summa cum laude) from Catholic University of Eichstaett-Ingolstadt, Germany. He was Assistant Lecturer at University of Muenster and at University of Eichstaett-Ingolstadt and received professional experience in banking (corporate banking, corporate restructuring) before joining University of Applied Sciences Schmalkalden. Prof. Dr. Schellberg's scientific and practical work has focussed on the reorganisation management of medium-sized enterprises and consumer insolvency.

His papers have been published in various scientific journals. Schellberg has additionally published several books.
