Why You Need a German Bank Account

- **Non-EU students:** You need a German bank account to manage your finances, including unblocking your blocked account.
- **EU students:** It's not required, but having a local bank account can make things easier.

SUNDIOCK Your Blocked Account (For Non-EU Students)

• Why do you need it? To obtain your visa and to access your €992/month living allowance.

Living in Schmalkalden costs less than €992 per month, but unfortunately the rules are the same all over Germany.

 - Check the bank's website for instructions.
 - Fill out a form and send it to the bank.

Req.: Passport and visa, Tax Number (if available), Confirmation of Registration.

Cost: €15 one-time fee (refunded after account closure).

How to Apply: Write an Email to **filiale.338@bbbank.de** with the subject *"Kontoeröffnung Hochschule Schmalkalden, z. Hd. Frau Sluka"* and write **io-mobility@hs-schmalkalden.de** in the cc, for a quick appointment.

Note: If you have a German phone number, you can also open it online.

Req.: Passport and visa, Tax Number (if available), Confirmation of Registration.

Cost: Free for EU students, $\in 6.50$ /month for non-EU.

How to Apply: Book online or call for an appointment.

Req.: Residence Permit, Confirmation of Registration, Passport, Tax Number (if available).

Cost: Free until age 26, €9.90/month after.

How to Apply: Call or visit the branch to get an appointment.

Req. Passport, Confirmation of Registration, German forms.

Cost: €8.50/month

How to Apply: Email io-mobility@hs-schmalkalden.de to book an appointment.

Important: Don't go to Sparkasse without an appointment; it may take weeks to get one.

Req.: Identity Card, Tax Number and, if applicable, Confirmation of Registration and Residence Permit (for non-EU citizens).

Cost: Free until age 21, €4.75/month after.

How to Apply: Book online or call for an appointment.

Requirements: Signed documents, Confirmation of Registration.

Cost: Free until age 28, then €4.90/month.

How to Apply: Complete and mail the forms, use PostIdent for verification.

DKB

Requirements: Residence Permit, Confirmation of Registration, Passport.

Cost: Free.

How to Apply: Online via Video Ident or at Deutsche Post.

Note: No account without a visa.

ING

Requirements: Tax Number, Passport, German Address.

Cost: Free until age 28 (with income > €699).

How to Apply: Online via Video Ident or at Deutsche Post.

Monese

Requirements: European Address.

Cost: Free (basic package).

How to Apply: <u>Download</u> the app and sign up.

Requirements: Check website for specific nationality requirements.

Cost: Free.

How to Apply: Online with Video Ident.
