

## Syllabus: "German as a Foreign Language A2.2"

### (a) Inhalt und Ansatz | Content and Approach

- The course provides knowledge of the German language in the areas of lexis, grammar, and phonetics and is oriented to the language competence level A2 of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR).
- Course content:
  - introduction and practice of vocabulary on topics such as daily life, media, politics, looking for a job, appointments describing people and places, being a host and a guest.
  - introduction and practice of grammatical structures such as article and noun declension in the nominative, dative, and accusative cases; verb forms in the present, past, and perfect tenses; verbs with separable and inseparable prefixes, reflexive verbs; demonstrative pronouns; adjective endings; main clauses and subordinate clauses; passive voice; reflexive pronouns and possessive pronouns, adverbs;
  - phonetics and listening comprehension exercises.
- This course is not intended for students with native language proficiency in German.
- Completion of assignments and regular attendance (at least 80% of all sessions) are required for exam.
- Upon successful completion of the course, students will receive 5 ECTS credits.
- The number of participants is limited.
- Registration via STUD.IP is required to participate in the course.

### (b) Qualifikationsziele | Learning Objectives

- The course focuses on communicative tasks aimed at building and improving students' ability to express themselves in everyday contexts.
- Students will be able to:
  - understand and use simple words, everyday expressions, and basic structures in familiar situations to respond to questions directed at them.
  - handle familiar situations with simple and memorized expressions and sentences related to everyday and concrete needs, although misunderstandings may occur.
  - communicate in a basic way when the conversation partner speaks slowly and clearly in standard language, is willing to repeat, and assists with formulation.
  - use some basic grammatical structures and sentence patterns in their expressions, connecting words, phrases, or short sentences with the most common conjunctions (and, but, or, then, because).
  - describe in simple terms aspects of his/her background, immediate environment and matters in areas of immediate need.
