Content	<p>This short course of lectures is designed to introduce Masters level students to the EU Law relating to Cross Border Insolvency. It will be looked at from a corporate perspective and will be delivered exclusively in the English language. The focus will be on the foundations laid by EU Reg 1346 of 2000 and its modification/restatement contained in EU Reg 848 of 2015.</p> <p>It will introduce students to the theories underpinning the regulations and also takes a critical perspective of the regulations especially when viewed from the English Common Law tradition of interpretation. Students will also be introduced to the primary decisions of the ECJ, especially that of Parmalat.</p> <p>Finally, students will be expected to engage in tutor led inter-active topical Case Studies and apply what they have studied ahead of their assessment</p>
