

Syllabus: “Spanish A1.2”

International School
Summer Term 2025, Gloria Valencia

(a) Inhalt und Ansatz | Content and Approach

- This course is designed for all students of Schmalkalden University of Applied Sciences from all faculties who have basic knowledge of the Spanish language (or can prove participation in the A1.1 Spanish course) and wish to continue learning the language.
- The course provides fundamental knowledge of the Spanish language in the areas of vocabulary, grammar, and phonetics, and is aligned with level A1.2 of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR).
- Course content:
 - Introduction and practice of vocabulary on topics such as: ordering in restaurants, shopping, describing cities and places, giving directions, booking accommodations, and describing leisure activities.
 - Introduction and practice of grammatical structures such as: vowel changes in irregular verbs in the present tense, the use of local prepositions, use of adverbs, reflexive verbs, comparatives and superlatives, demonstratives, and the perfect tense.
 - Exercises in phonetics and listening comprehension.
- This course is not intended for students with native language proficiency in Spanish
- Registration on Stud.IP is required to take part in the course.

(b) Qualifikationsziele | Learning Objectives

- The course focuses on communicative tasks aimed at building and improving the ability to express oneself in everyday contexts
- The students will be able to
 - understand individual sentences and frequently used expressions, such as simple personal information, studies, work, immediate surroundings, hotel reservations, or shopping. Additionally, they will be able to comprehend phrases and short conversations related to routine activities performed in the past tense.
 - read simple texts such as advertisements, menus, or timetables, and find specific predictable information, as well as understand simple personal letters.
 - communicate in simple, routine situations where a direct and straightforward exchange of information on familiar topics and activities is required.
 - write simple messages and short texts, such as invitations or brief replies, referring to personal matters or asking for and conveying information from everyday life.
