



Scholarship Programme STIBET I - Scholarships and Supervision Programme for International Students and Doctoral Candidates

During the **summer semester 2022**, the International Office will be awarding scholarships funded by the German Foreign Office, for particularly committed students within the framework of the DAAD STIBET I programme. These scholarships are aimed at international students at Schmalkalden University of Applied Sciences who distinguish themselves through their commitment within an international context in their programme and/or at the university.

The scholarships will be awarded by a selection committee with special consideration given to good performance during previous studies and special commitment in the international context of the university. They will be awarded in the amount of 900 € respectively, which corresponds to 300 € per month for a period of three months.

Students at Schmalkalden University of Applied Sciences are eligible to apply:

- If they are foreign students with foreign citizenship;
- If they have studied at Schmalkalden University for at least two semesters and have achieved good to very good results in their studies to date;
- If they have distinguished themselves through outstanding commitment in an international context at Schmalkalden University of Applied Sciences;
- If they can demonstrate intercultural competence as well as a good knowledge of German and English.

Students of the Schmalkalden University of Applied Sciences are not eligible to apply:

- If they are in Schmalkalden for an exchange stay and short-term studies;
- If they hold German citizenship;
- If they have acquired a German university entrance qualification at a school in Germany or a German school abroad;
- If they are abroad for a practical phase or exchange studies.

Required documents for application:

- Motivation letter with specific mention of your social commitment;
- Current certificate of commitment during your studies;
- Current certificate of study and copy of student card;
- Current overview of grades;
- Copy of the high school diploma;
- Curriculum vitae.

Please note: Applications that are incomplete or not submitted by the deadline cannot be considered.
