<b>Content</b>	Learning activities for the course include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Reading texts about linguistic concepts;</li><li>- Analyzing linguistic data;</li><li>- Discussing linguistic phenomena in languages that students speak as well as a variety of world languages.</li></ul>
