<b>Content</b>	The lecture gives an overview of the conflict of laws which decide which applicable law rules international contracts, e. g. international contracts for the sale of goods, international contracts for the provision of services. The focus is on the Regulation (EC) No 593/2008 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 17 June 2008 on the law applicable to contractual obligations (Rome I).
