

German language courses during the semester

The German courses offered throughout the semester are open to all foreign students of the Schmalkalden University of Applied Sciences who want to improve their knowledge of German during their stay in Germany. The courses are free of charge and cover the levels A1 – C1 as defined by the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages. In order to join the German language courses, students must take the placement test at the beginning of each semester. Students who miss the placement test but still want to attend one of the German language courses should contact Ms. Petschauer (ra.petschauer@hs-sm.de). What can you expect?

- 5 German classes per week with experienced language teachers (approx. 75 classes / term)
- a language exam at the end of the semester
- a language certificate from the Schmalkalden University of Applied Sciences
- 8 ECTS if you attend the course regularly and pass the final exam
