



Scholarships for Studying and Internships Abroad Sponsored by the DAAD “PROMOS” Student Mobility Program

Schmalkalden University of Applied Sciences provides scholarships for students who wish to study or complete an internship abroad. These scholarships, which aim to support the international mobility of students studying at German universities, are financed by the DAAD (Department P14) in cooperation with the German Federal Ministry of Education and Research (BMBF).

Students of the Schmalkalden University of Applied Sciences who have concrete plans to study or intern abroad are eligible to apply for this scholarship.

Please note that we only offer partial scholarships.

The deadline to apply is **31st January for the summer semester and 31st May for the autumn semester**. This deadline is strict and late applications will not be considered.

Application requirements:

- Semester or internship outside of Europe
- You must be enrolled at the Schmalkalden University of Applied Sciences
- Recipients of “BAföG” financial aid must inform the BAföG office if they receive PROMOS funding

Application documents:

- Application Form (from the Department of Studies and International Relations)
- Cover letter explaining your motivation for going abroad and explaining how you plan to finance your semester/internship abroad
- Tabular CV
- List of previously acquired studies (Transcript of records self-printed)
- Copy of your student ID
- Proof of language proficiency, if available
- Letter of Acceptance of the host university, internship contract, or similar (If you have not received this letter, you can attach this document later)
- If available, certificates or confirmations of voluntary work

****Please note that you are required to inform the Department of Studies and International Relations of any other funding you are receiving/applying for during your time abroad.****
